Check List for Survivors

We have published the following check list over the years. Have had a few requests recently so will publish it again. Would be a good idea for couples to discuss this information.

We have collected several items to serve as a check list for use at the time of death of a retiree or spouse. This is a very stressful period and hopefully the list will provide a starting point in getting on with activities that need doing. By the very fact that we are all have different assets each case will be different. Always remember that the FIN group is there to help so don't hesitate to call one of them. Their phone numbers are always listed on the last page of each newsletter.

KEEP A COPY OF THIS SHEET.

a. Immediate contacts

1. family, friends, business associates, clubs, etc.
2. church, temple, etc.
3. funeral home

b. Soon after contacts

1. U.C.C. retiree services-----1-800-344-0661 (benefits, savings plan, life insurance, etc.). This could also be done by a member of the family or close friend.

* You will need: your S.S. number - deceased S.S. number

* Retiree services will send information packet and will request certain information. This could take several weeks.

* A death certificate will be required. the number will depend on number of insurance policies, stocks, bonds, etc. a good starting point would be 10- 12 and more if there are several of the above items.

2. Lawyer (will, trust, etc.)
3. Banks, Credit Union (safe deposit box, change account name/beneficiary), credit cards
4. Broker (change account name/beneficiary)
5. Social Security office (stop monthly payments, burial benefits, etc.)

c. Later contacts

1. Life Insurance Companies (private, government, etc.)
2. Tax office (tax payment, addressee name change, etc.)
3. Check for securities not with a broker (change name/beneficiary)
4. Automobiles (change name in title, notify insurance company)
5. Airlines if any frequent flyer accounts (some will transfer mileage balance to spouse)
